

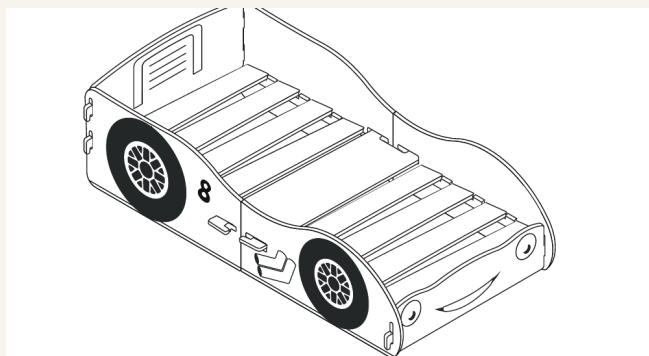

Before you start

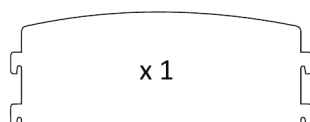
- 1 Adult assembly only** This bed should only be assembled by an adult.
- 2 Check the parts** Compare everything in the box with the parts list before you begin.
- 3 Build in the room** Choose a clear, level working area close to where the bed will be used.
- 4 Keep this guide** Store these instructions somewhere safe for future reference.

Check all six component types before assembly.

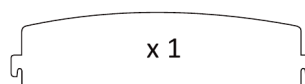

03 Centre support x 1

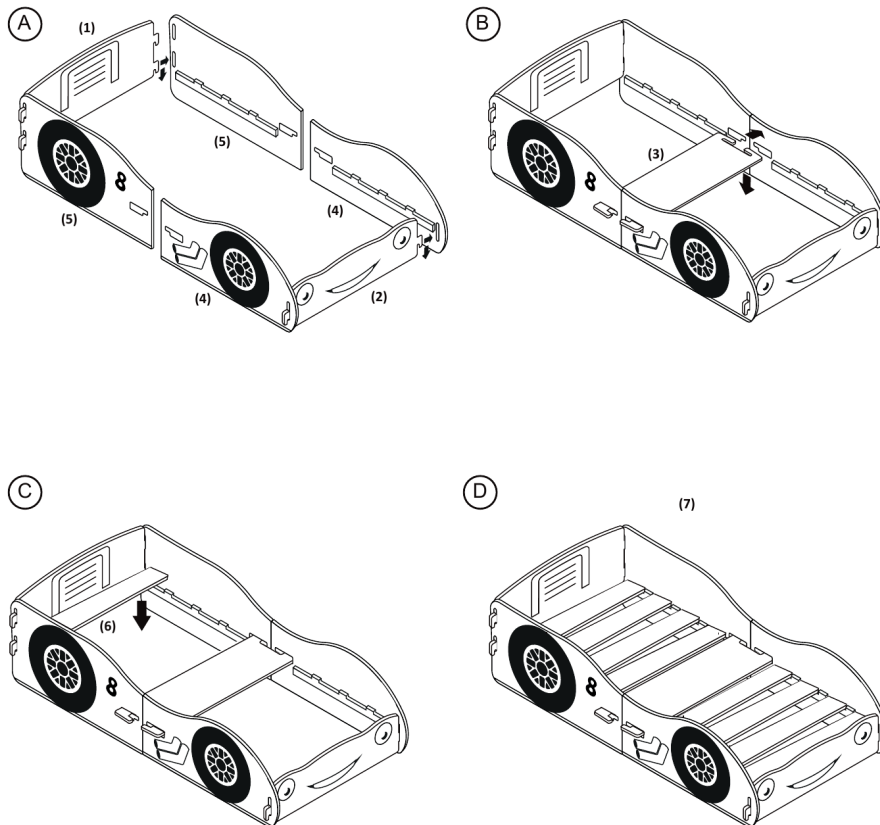
04 Front side panel x 2

Put the bed together

Follow the Kidsaw diagrams in order: A, B, C and D.



1

Fit the side panels

Slot the back side panels (5) into the headboard (1). Fit the front side panels (4) into the footboard (2).

2

Join the frame

Bring the front and back side panels together. Insert the centre support (3) into the holes on one side, then repeat on the opposite side.

3

Add the slats

Place the slats (6) evenly across the frame, fitting each end into the side panel supports. Make sure all slats are secure.

Use it safely

Important guidance for the Kidsaw Racing Car Junior Bed.

Safety essentials

- Suitable for children aged 18 months to 4 years.
- Use a cot mattress measuring approximately 10cm high x 70cm wide x 140cm deep.
- Do not place the bed near heat sources, windows or other furniture.
- Do not use the bed if any part is broken, torn or missing.
- Keep the bed tight to a wall, or allow at least 300mm between the bed and the wall / nearby furniture.
- Only use replacement parts approved by Kidsaw Ltd.
- Periodically check that all fittings remain secure.

Care & maintenance

- ✓ Wipe surfaces with a damp cloth.
- ✓ Avoid abrasive, ammonia based, bleach or spirit type cleaners.
- ✓ Re-check the bed and fittings from time to time.
